## SCENARIO OF DAIRY, LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY INDUSTRY IN KENYA

- ✦ The government of Kenya has launched the Kenya Dairy Industry Sustainability Roadmap 2023 – 2033, geared towards increasing dairy farmer's income by doubling their milk production per cow.
- ✦ Kenya has an estimated dairy herd population of 5.1 million and over two million smallholder dairy farmers with an estimated annual production of 5.2 billion litres of milk valued at over Sh.230 billion
- ✦ Data from the ministry indicate that Kenya produced 5.2 billion liters of milk in 2023 and targets to increase the figure to 10 billion liters by 2030. Mueke noted that the strategy promotes investments in dairy export processing zones to increase exports by 200 million liters annually.
- ✦ Chickens were the largest species of livestock in Kenya as of 2020. That year, there were around 59 million heads of chickens in the country. Goats followed, with approximately 32 million heads. Moreover, Kenya summed 24.8 million heads of sheep and some 22.8 million heads of cattle.
- ✦ Kenya has started accepting technological & methodical innovations in Dairy Farming & Poultry Farming.
- ✦ Recently various financial Institutions such as Kenya Livestock Farming Trust have come ahead to give credit facility to poultry and Dairy Farmers for the growth of the Industry.
- ✦ Livestock sector & Poultry sector accounts for 12.7% of GDP of Africa.

## THE FUTURE OF THE INDUSTRY

Technological advancements in automation, genetics, and feed management will drive efficiency. Sustainable farming practices like water-efficient systems and renewable energy will play a crucial role. Government policies aim to support local production, create jobs, and reduce reliance on imports. Growth in export markets for meat, dairy, and poultry products will strengthen the industry's global presence.

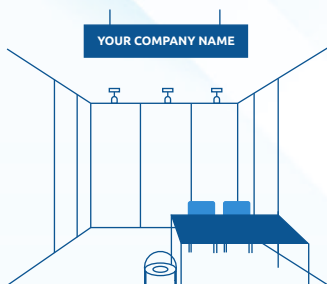
